We require the offender, the date, the summary of the incident and the fine for the 13 abatement notices and the 9 infringement notices. Our understanding is we have only been provided with the prosecutions. We do not believe the extra information should cost us \$7080 plus GST as stated in your email (27<sup>th</sup> November 2012). We believe the information should be easily available if Mr Chamberlain was able to quote this at the Petroleum Summit in September.
- 2. We ask for the third time (22<sup>nd</sup> November 2012, 29<sup>th</sup> November 2012) and request a response ...
  - 2.1 Why are Taranaki Regional Council publically endorsing the Todd Energy Submission on Hydraulic Fracturing to the Parliamentary Commissioner for the Environment? The Company was given a poor rating for environmental performance by Taranaki Regional Council in 2011 and does not appear to be improving. Please refer to the attached Todd Taranaki Mangahewa-C wellsite report 2009-2010 (March 2011) supplied by Mr McLay in an email on 28<sup>th</sup> February 2012. We also include 'non-compliant' incidents documented by Taranaki Regional Council on 25<sup>th</sup> July 2012 where Todd was fined for breaching consent at two sites.
